

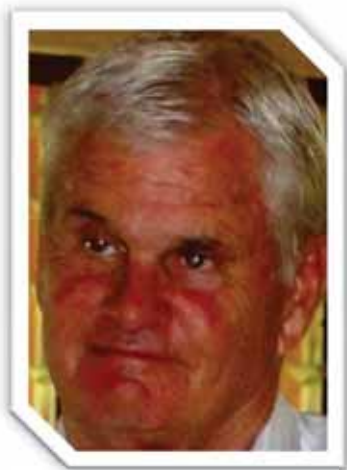

Anglers feedback / Hengelaars terugvoering:

Species, Species, Species rule the 16th 3 Ships Inhaca Game Fish Challenge

As the 36 boats approached the beautiful island of Inhaca some 32km off shore of Maputo harbour there was a true expectation of fair weather and amazing catches that were experienced last year. The function was opened by the new 3 Ships Inhaca Challenge organizer Gavin Martins who thanked all the local dignitaries as well as the Mozambique Authorities whom without their help this competition would not be possible.

This year's sponsors contributed over half a millions worth of prizes, in these tough economic times a truly generous contribution. Spirits were dampened long before sunrise on the first day, when the wind was recorded at 27knots on the end of the pier. Although there was no fishing on the first day the afternoon weigh in and prize giving were still held. The five "heavy weights" of the competition weighed in, in excess of 840kg!

Fishing conditions on the second day were tough and all boats fished in uncomfortable conditions. With species earning a multiplication of points, the local boat from Maputo "Sholay" came in first followed by "Sea Nergy" and "My Cat". Top fish of the day went to the boat "Top Shot".

The weather calmed on day 3 and the fleet were enthusiastic about a good days angling. Fish were very shy and proved difficult to hook. Once again species were the answer with boat "My Cat" taking the day. Also maximising points on species and in second was the boat "Gone Overboard". In third spot for the day was "On Strike". Biggest fish of the day a Couta of 13,3kg came off the boat "Frisky Girl"

The "Weather Gods" once again prevented the fleet from Launching on the 4th day. Friday how ever gave the fleet a gap and the fishing time was extended by an hour to catch up for time lost. Once again the top boats on the final day cashed in on the species factor with "My Cat" edging out local boat "Sholay" into second spot for the day. Biggest fish of the day went to the boat "Supremasea" with a nice Couta of 17kg.

Excitement was in the air as allknew that the final tally on points would be a close one. In the end it was "My Cat" skippered by Pierre Pienaar (378.2points) that just piped "Sholay" skippered by BinoNordine. Third spot went to "Sea Nergy" skippered by Theo Isaiah. The top boat ended up with a total of 9 species, proving that this is the code to winning the Challenge.

Top angler was Richard Martins on Sholay followed up by Theo Isaiah on Sea Nergy and Theo van der Walt fishing on My Cat. The R34000.00 "Calcutta for the biggest fish of the competition was taken with a 17,7kg Yellow fin Tuna, angler Lomar Breedt on the boat "Top Shot". Although the Challenge is a largely game fish tournament, therelease of Bill Fish is recognized. A total of 13 Sailfish and 1 Marlin were released for the 3 days fished. Top billfish release team was taken by the Swaziland boat "On Strike" followed by "My Cat" on a count out. In 3rd spot was "Denwa One" with the release of a Marlin. The 3 juniors who fished in the competition all received a subscription to Ski Boat Magazine.

Once again the release of a selected species of Game Fish proved to be accepted with 28 fish being releasedsuccessfully. 3 fish of over a meter long were released on 10kg line. This is truly a great achievement.

A big thanks to Gavin Martins and the Organising committee of the Inhaca Challenge for an extremely well organized competition. Till next May...

Fishermen in 'miracle' rescue

Cape Town - A father and son from Paternoster, lost at sea, drifting in an open boat in fog and rain for two icy nights, were rescued on Friday after what locals described as a miraculous sighting by a random fishing boat.

Christy Jordaan, 59, and Brandon, 36, were spotted just before 3pm. They were ferried to hospital immediately.

Craig Lambinon, NSRI spokesman, said the two were in "good spirits". Paternoster resident Ursula Walters added: "They're very weak... but it's just a miracle."

The two rescued men are the husband and son of Berandina Jordaan, a DA municipal councillor from Paternoster. She had said earlier yesterday that both men were professional fishermen, and that she hoped they would be found soon.

The men had been at sea in their open boat for more than 48 hours, in swells of up to 6m high, and through swirling fog, rain and two icy nights on the Atlantic. They were spotted by chance by a fishing vessel off the coast of Saldanha Bay – far further south than they were believed to be.

The pair had drifted less than 30km, but in the past two days of thick fog and inclement weather, they had been all but invisible to those searching for them.

Lambinon said the hardship of the men's ordeal disappeared in the celebration as the family was reunited at the Saldanha Bay yacht club.

The drama began at 2.55pm on Wednesday when the Mykonos NSRI duty crew were called out for a fishing boat that had lost motor power and was adrift at sea.

A huge rescue effort was launched. For the first 18 hours, the men remained in contact with their would-be rescuers. But despite an extensive search the rescue teams could not find them.

"Dressed warmly and with life-jackets, the men were instructed to anchor... and the search resumed at first light (on Thursday)," reported Gerard Brune, NSRI Mykonos station commander. The search then expanded to a far larger area, but was hampered by thick fog. Then cellphone reception was lost at about 9am on Thursday.

The multi-team search continued until late on Thursday night. The two were still in hospital last night, Lambinon said.

Cold weather fishing tips from Angling & Outdoor World (by Michael Cronje)

Bass:

Bait selection at this time is critical. In very cold water, a bass will move only a minimal distance for food. The bait of choice has to be something that is equal or greater than the energy expended. The use of large, slow moving baits is the key. Don't be afraid to throw 10-inch or 12-inch plastics, like the Zoom "Ol' Monster" and 10-inch Berkley "Power Worm" range of lures, where you once threw a 4-inch offering. All our soft plastic bass baits are less 20% until Saturday 11 May 2013.

Carp:

Carp will feed less when it's cold. If you can tempt them to take a bait in the cold, then you want a hook in it! However, baiting an area is still very important. Just don't over bait your area. Go for stiffer hook lengths on your rigs and target deeper areas. Cold water carp are not likely to be involved in competitive feeding. They are moving around less and generally picking at odd baits so use a rig that is difficult to eject. Our Carp Hunter high protein boilies are on sale for R59.00 per 800g bag. Top flavours at the moment are Pepper Peach, Chilli Hemp and Secret Spice.

Flyfishing: Trout:

Look for rises. You'll see the most surface activity mid-afternoon. The water is by and large clear so opt for smaller flies and thinner tippet. You can use 4X leaders under most conditions and flies that tend to produce well are Pheasant Tail Nymphs, Epoxy Buzzers, RABs, Pancora Woolly Buggers and, if you are that way inclined, Egg Flies. We stock a massive range of Sci-Flies selling from R21.00 for a pack of three.

Deep Sea:

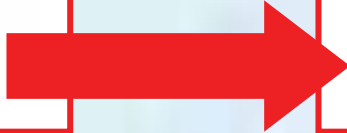
