## **NDHK Voorsitters Verslag 2017**

## **Responsible Angling Guidelines: South Africa**

Marine and estuarine angling is a popular pastime enjoyed by hundreds of thousands of people in South Africa. Anglers contribute significantly to the economic and socio-economic values of the South African economy and over the past century the number of participants in the fishery has increased substantially, although catch rates have steadily decreased. Despite the popular belief that anglers have a lesser impact than commercial fishing industries, the collective impact by hundreds of thousands of marine and estuarine anglers has taken its toll on fish populations. Many popular target species are slow growing and have complicated life histories and are therefore not resilient to harvesting pressures. Anglers often release fish for multiple reasons, be it as part of the fishing regulations (e.g. undersized, over bag limit or during a closed season) or as a voluntary moral decision made by conservation-minded anglers. It is crucial that any released fish has the best chance of survival to ensure the sustainability of recreational angling. Years of dedicated research has resulted in the collection of scientific knowledge that can be translated into a number of practical steps to improve responsible angling. By adhering to the recommendations of this document, anglers can make a difference to the future of recreational angling and contribute to reversing the actions of past generations who did not have the knowledge that is available today. An angler who is mindful of the impacts of his/her activities and takes measures to reduce them, has taken the first steps towards being a responsible angler and an ambassador to the future of recreational angling in South Africa.

### **The Top 15 Qualities of a Responsible Angler:**

The responsible angler not only adheres to recreational permit conditions and regulations but also adopts an ethical code of conduct to ensure they are going above and beyond the rules to reduce the impacts of angling.

#### **A Responsible Recreational Angler:**

- 1) Has a valid recreational angling permit and is familiar and respectful of all the relevant regulations;
- 2) Seeks information and remains informed about the status of marine resources and the impacts of angling on species and habitats;
- 3) Is adaptable to change and embraces national policy adjustments that will benefit the status of marine resources;
- 4) Acts responsibly when exposed to activities that will negatively impact on the conservation of marine resources;
- 5) Collects bait with the minimum disturbance to the environment;
- 6) Only keeps fish and bait sufficient for their immediate needs and does not sell fish;
- 7) Handles all illegal or unwanted fish, regardless of species, in a way that ensures their best chance of survival;
- 8) Quickly and humanely kills retained fish to ensure the least amount of suffering;
- 9) Uses equipment and tackle that minimizes stress and injury to fish;
- 10) Appreciates the environmental and social value of a healthy environment and always leaves the fishing area in the same or better condition than when he/she arrived;
- 11) Reports illegal activities including environmental damage and pollution, to the relevant authorities;
- 12) Uses established legal roads and tracks when accessing fishing areas;
- 13) Is considerate of other legitimate marine users and respects their right to access marine resources;
- 14) Educates others, especially children, in sustainable fishing practices;
- 15) Is a role model to other anglers and always leads by example.



### **Do fish feel pain?**

The topic of fish welfare or whether fish feel pain has been debated for many years. Although an animal's mental state is difficult to measure, it can be connected to the animal's ability to freely perform natural behaviors without pain, fear or stress. A fish that is caught and released may survive the process, but reproduction, feeding and growth may be negatively affected due to the energy required to recover from the associated injury and/or stress. The humane treatment of fish, including live-bait, not only reflects a high moral standard of the recreational fishing community, but is also in the best interests of the future of recreational fishing. Below are some recommendations for the ethical treatment of retained fish and the best practices for catch and release angling.

### **The Ethical Treatment of Retained Fish:**

Many recreational anglers enjoy eating the fish they catch and as long as this is done within the regulations and their personal needs, there is nothing wrong with this practice. However, the treatment of retained fish should be considered. The most humane method to euthanize a fish is to first render the fish unconscious with a sharp blow to the head and then cut through the base of the fish's gills so it can bleed out. To reduce spoilage, retained fish should be gutted and cleaned as soon as possible after capture and stored in a cool place, preferably with ice.

### **Essential Tackle Box Items:**

The following items are tackle box essentials that will ensure a fish is released as quickly as possible with the least amount of harm. As soon as a fish is hooked, a fishing companion should assist with the landing and release process to optimize release time. These items must be within quick reach to reduce the time it takes for the fish to be returned to the water:

- Long-nose pliers: useful for removing a hook set in the jaw and for squashing barbs;
- Side-cutters: Use to cut through line or steel trace if the hook is swallowed;
- Measuring tape: use a measuring tape to record the length of the fish. The length can be converted to weight using an online species length/weight relationship or downloadable app for all types of mobile phones;
- Measuring mat: if fishing from the shore or boat a measuring mat can be useful. Always ensure the mat is wet and cool before placing fish on for measuring. Smaller skates and rays can be placed on a measuring mat to avoid sand entering the gills on their underside.
- Waterproof camera: keep a waterproof camera close by to ensure a quicker release if a photograph is desired;

### **Responsible Bait Collection:**

Bait species that live in the sediment such as sand and mud prawns often co-exist with many other much smaller organisms that make habitats such as sand and mud banks extremely productive. Unsustainable harvesting, habitat destruction and disturbance can have serious implications for other animals, such as birds, crabs and fish that use these habitats as feeding grounds. Make sure you have the necessary bait collecting permits, adhere to the daily bag limits and store bait in a manner that ensures the least amount of waste. Only use legal tools for collecting bait to limit the destruction caused during the bait collection process. Sea-grass beds in estuaries are important nursery grounds and should be avoided when collecting bait. Fish intended for use as live-bait should be kept in a large enough live-well that is out of direct sunlight and well oxygenated with a battery-operated air pump that is kept running continuously. Refresh the live-well water regularly to ensure good water quality. Excess live-bait should be released or euthanized and frozen for future use.

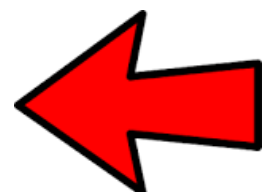

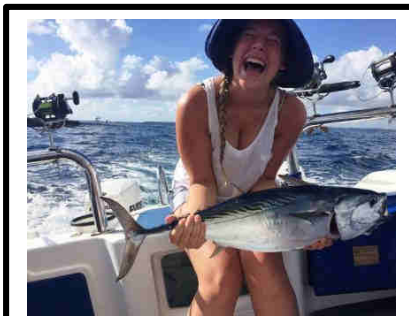

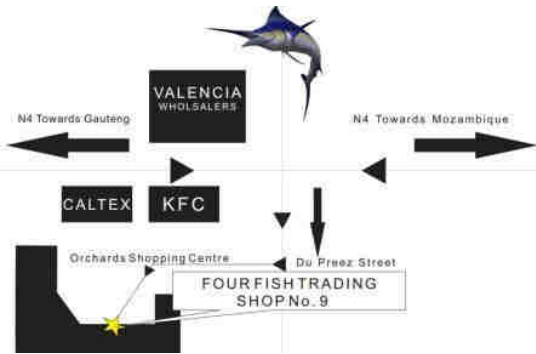
